MEMORANDUM FOR HAWAII WING SQUADRON COMMANDERS

SUBJECT: Updated Squadron and Wing Patch

1. Aloha Commanders, in accordance with CAPR 110-3, our Wing is transitioning to approved formatted patches. Each Squadron must submit a new design or the original Squadron design to the Wing Director of Public Affairs, 2d Lt Janel Fujinaka, by 1700 on 31 May 2023 for National Headquarters approval.
2. Upon submission and approval, Squadrons will be given five years to transition to their new Squadron Patch. The old Squadron patch will be sent to the Wing Historian for archiving. For continuity, a copy of the approved new Squadron patch design will be kept on file with the Wing Director of Public Affairs and Wing Director of Administration. All Squadrons shall also maintain a copy of their updated patch.
3. The Hawaii Wing and the Cadet Training Group patches are also undergoing changes and will have the same five-year transition period.
4. By 2028, all Hawaii Wing members will be expected to wear the approved patches on the required uniforms outlined in CAPR 39-1 and HIWG Supplement 39-1 unless National Headquarters send new directives. Should there be any questions, please reach out to 2d Lt Janel Fujinaka or me.
